Form 1 (Heroic Age=1000-1600; Chronological study: 1606-Present)

\*A three year cycle, each column represents the time period to be covered in any year. There is an option for subsequent children come into the rotation wherever any older Form 1 children are, cycling back to the beginning as needed, rather than starting with the Heroic Age year--a plan CM included for home schoolrooms.
